The Center for Training Transportation Professionals (CTTP) at the University of Arkansas provides a comprehensive training and certification program for highway agency and contractor personnel performing quality control and quality assurance (QC/QA) testing on pavements and construction materials in the state of Arkansas. CTTP is seeking applications for a Program Specialist, who is expected to continually maintain and update the CTTP website, to provide classroom and laboratory instruction, and technical/instructional support for the laboratory certification and technology transfer programs. Assistance with most CTTP functions will be required, with emphasis on website development and instruction.

The CTTP Program Specialist is a full-time non-classified position with benefits as determined by the University of Arkansas.
